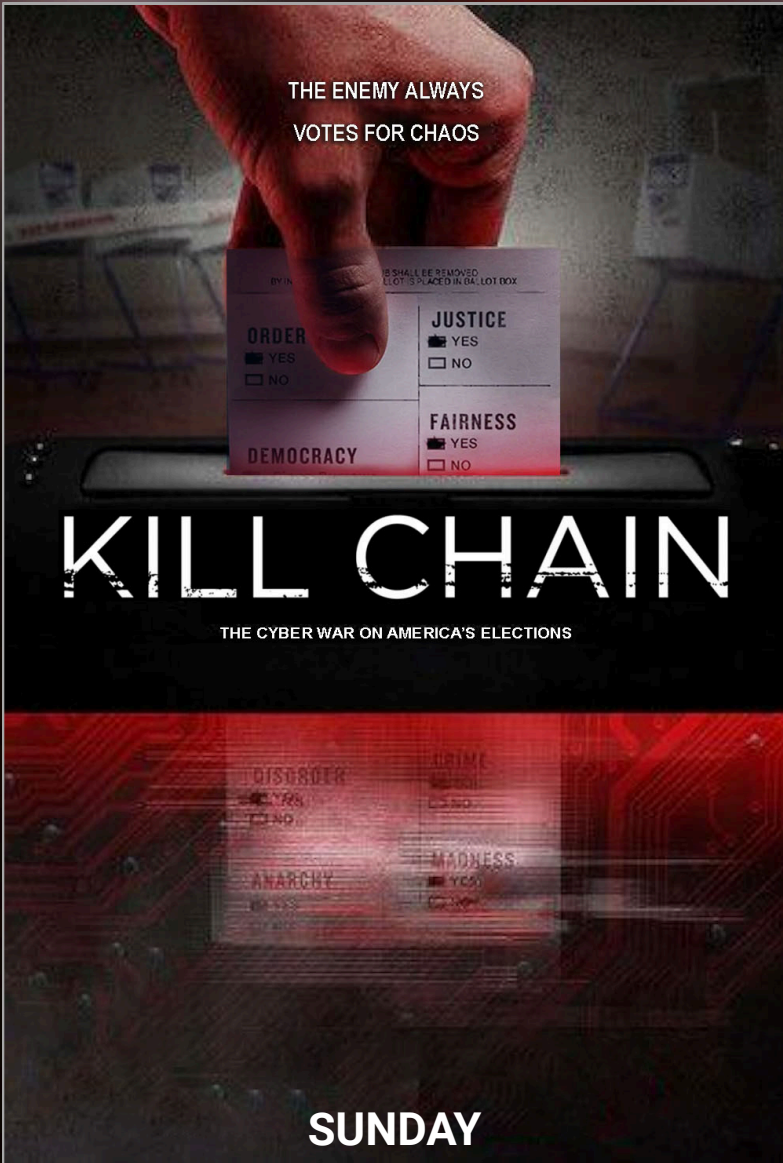

To what extent should we fear the possibility of a tampered election? With the end of voting in the 2024 presidential election at our doorstep, Kill Chain: The Cyber War on America's Elections (2020) continues to hold relevancy. Directors Simon Ardizzone, Russell Michaels and Sarah Teale construct the chilling and convincing argument that the American voting system is outdated and riddled with vulnerabilities.

The film follows Harri Hursti, an election security expert specializing in hacking techniques and voting security, as he systematically explores the fragility of the 2016 U.S. election. Hursti is a familiar figure from Ardizzone and Michaels' previous film, Hacking Democracy (2006), where he demonstrated, with a simple memory card, how easy it was to alter votes in digital voting machines.

That same machine model slated for use in twenty states for the 2020 election according to Verified Voting, which is cited in the film.

The documentary presents its concerns in a straightforward way, requiring no computer background nor election voting system knowledge to understand.
